# Kathaumixw 2006

Every other summer choirs from around the world meet on the edge of British Columbia's coastal wilderness in the town of Powell River to share their music and love of singing. The **International Choral Kathaumixw Festival** has become known worldwide for its friendly musical atmosphere and beautiful setting in nature.

Located on the Sunshine Coast about 80 air miles north of Vancouver, **Powell River** is lapped by the waters of Malaspina Strait and nestled against the Coastal Mountain Range. To the west of this community of 20,000 are Texada and Harwood islands, Georgia Strait and the snow capped peaks of Vancouver Island.

Powell River is home to the internationally acclaimed **Powell River Academy** choirs that, under the direction of **Don James**, have received many honours and awards. They have toured extensively in North America and abroad.

**Kathaumixw** (pronounced Ka-thou-mew) is the local Coast Salish First Nation word meaning "a gathering together of different peoples".

**Kathaumixw 2006** will be the XII International Choral Kathaumixw Festival.

All participants are assured a warm and friendly reception from their hosts and the many people attending **Kathaumixw**.

Kathaumixw, a project of the **Powell River Academy of Music**, features:

- *18 international concerts*
- *common singing*
- *competitions*
- *conductors' round tables*
- *concert tours*
- *social events*



## International Concerts

Kathaumixw presents 18 international concerts during the festival. Participating choirs perform in a minimum of two and a maximum of four concerts. In most cases choirs share concerts with other participating choirs.

## Common Singing

Each day all choirs rehearse together a common repertoire which is performed in the Gala Closing Concert. These rehearsals are led by members of the distinguished choral jury.

## Competitions

Participating choirs and soloists may enter various competitions. The competitions are for amateur choirs and singers and are judged by a jury of internationally renowned musicians. First and second prizes are awarded in each category. First prize winners perform in the **Kathaumixw Awards Concert**.

The competitions are divided into three categories:

### Category 1

#### 101 Childrens' Choirs (maximum age 16)

Choirs must perform three contrasting compositions:

- an original composition written before 1900.
- an original composition by a composer of the choir's own country, sung in any language.
- a folk song or folk song arrangement.

Total performance time (all 3 pieces) must not exceed 13 minutes.

#### 102 Youth Choir SSA or SATB (maximum age 25)

Choirs must perform:

- an original composition written before 1900.
- an original composition by a composer of

the choir's own country, sung in any language.

- a folk song or folk song arrangement.

Total performance time (all 3 pieces) must not exceed 13 minutes.

#### 103 Adult Mixed Choir

Choirs must perform:

- an original composition written before 1900.
- an original composition by a composer of the choir's own country, sung in any language.
- a folk song or folk song arrangement.

Total performance time (all 3 pieces) must not exceed 13 minutes.

#### 104 Adult Equal Voice Choir (Female or Male)

Choirs must perform three contrasting compositions:

- an original composition written before 1900.
- an original composition by a composer of the choir's own country, sung in any language.
- a folk song or folk song arrangement.

Total performance time (all 3 pieces) must not exceed 13 minutes.

#### Prizes for categories 101 to 104:

First Place \$500 CDN &  
Kathaumixw Trophy  
Second Place \$250 CDN.

### Category 2

#### 201 Chamber Choir

For choral ensembles of not less than 6 and not more than 16 singers. Ensembles must perform two contrasting compositions:

- one from the sacred repertoire
- one from the secular repertoire.

Total performance time (both pieces) must not exceed 10 minutes.

## 202 Contemporary Choral Music

Choirs must perform two compositions written after 1900 displaying innovative and important contemporary compositional techniques.

Total performance time (both pieces) must not exceed 10 minutes.

## 203 Folk & Cultural Traditions

Choirs must perform two contrasting pieces that reflect their country, region or cultural traditions. Authentic costumes, instruments and movement may be used where appropriate.

Total performance time (both pieces) must not exceed 10 minutes.

### Prizes for Categories 201 to 203:

First Place \$300 CDN  
Second Place \$150 CDN.

## Category 3

### 301 Vocal Solo

(maximum age 16)

Soloists must sing two contrasting compositions:

- one from the sacred repertoire
- one from the secular repertoire.

Total performance time (both pieces) must not exceed 10 minutes.

### 302 Vocal Solo

(maximum age 21)

Soloists must sing two contrasting compositions:

- one from the sacred repertoire
- one from the secular repertoire.

Total performance time (both pieces) must not exceed 10 minutes.

### 303 Vocal Solo

(over 21 years of age)

Soloists must sing two contrasting compositions:

- one from the sacred repertoire
- one from the secular repertoire.

Total performance time (both pieces) must not exceed 10 minutes.

### Prizes for competitions 301 to 303:

First Place \$100 CDN.  
Second Place \$50 CDN.

## Conductors' Round Tables

Informal lunch sessions are held for conductors to discuss repertoire, techniques, trends and to share ideas from many countries. The "round table" discussion leaders include outstanding choral conductors and jury members.

## Concert Tours

The Kathaumixw Tour committee will arrange concert tours in the Pacific Northwest for interested visiting choirs. Tour arrangements include: performance venues, concert promotion, land travel, accommodation and some meals, volunteer tour hosts and sightseeing excursions.

The concert tours will take place the week following the festival. Further information including tour options and costs will be made available on request.

## Social Events

During the festival there are various receptions, banquets, barbecues and other social events for participants. Excursions will be made available at cost to experience the natural beauty of the area.

## Accommodation

Accommodation is coordinated and allocated by the Festival and includes home stay (for overseas choirs only), hotel and basic dormitory. Accommodation is limited to singers, conductor, accompanist and one accompanying adult per ten singers for childrens' and youth choirs.

Because of limited accommodation, all other persons wishing to attend the festival will be housed at their cost after festival participants have been accommodated.

## Choir Applications

- Choirs applying to participate in the festival

- must use the Kathaumixw Application Form. Application forms must reach the office of the International Choral Kathaumixw on or before November 1, 2005.
- The following must be submitted with the application form:
- short biography of the choir (maximum 100 words) and the conductor (maximum 75 words)
- a recent recording of the choir
- photograph of the choir
- photograph of the conductor

## Acceptance

The festival committee will notify choirs whether or not they are accepted as participants by December 15, 2005.

Artistic and other factors play a role in the decisions of the committee.

There will be a maximum number of choirs per category and a limited number of entries per country.

## Confirmation

Choirs must confirm their participation in writing by January 15, 2006. A non-refundable deposit of 50% of the total participation fees must accompany this confirmation. If the confirmation and payment are not received by the due date, the festival reserves the right to accept another ensemble on the waiting list.

## Participation Fee

Choirs and soloists must pay a \$185 CDN participation fee per participant. "Participants" include singers, conductor, accompanist, manager and chaperones. The participation fee covers the cost of concert tickets, competitions, social events, festival transportation, swimming pool pass, festival program and other festival activities.

***The official currency of the festival is the Canadian dollar.***

## Obligations

Each participating choir is obliged:

- to participate in the planned schedule for the whole festival period July 4-8, 2006.
- to waive all rights associated with radio, television, Internet broadcasting and audio and video recordings.
- to waive all rights to any form of financial compensation.

## Vocal Solo Applications

Vocal soloists applying to participate in the festival must use the Kathaumixw Application Form. Application forms must reach the office of the International Choral Kathaumixw on or before April 15, 2006. Each choir may enter up to 5 soloists. Competitors must meet the age requirements specified in the competition categories.

## Music

**Choirs** entered in choral competitions must provide three original copies of their selected music to the secretary of the International Choral July 15 minutes prior to the competition. The Festival will retain one copy.

**Soloists** entered in the vocal solo competitions must provide one original copy of their selected music to the secretary of the International Vocal Solo July 15 minutes prior to the competition.

**Competitors** using unpublished compositions or music in manuscript form must provide written authorization for its use from the copyright owner.

**Accepted choirs** will receive one copy of each of the **common songs** to be learned by all choirs. Choirs are responsible for obtaining additional copies. Photocopying without permission is a violation of international copyright law.
